JustFaith Ministries forms, informs and transforms people of faith by offering programs and resources that sustain them in their compassionate commitment to build a more just and peaceful world.

- Consider taking part in a justice formation process called "JustFaith" that will begin at our parish this fall. The program includes readings, videos, face-to-face encounters with the poor, and an investigation into the intersection of spirituality and Christian activism. JustFaith will run from September to May.

- Do you yearn for a deeper, broader spirituality? Are you willing to walk toward that goal? If so, we invite you to consider Engaging Spirituality. Engaging Spirituality is a new JustFaith Ministries program that invites adult Christians to explore the intersection between contemplative presence and social action, as it is lived out in our lives. The process draws on the wisdom and practices of our Catholic contemplative tradition for the transformation of our lives and our world. These include: discernment, Lectio Divina, silence, journal-keeping, sacred listening, spiritual reading, Centering Prayer, and social outreach; and are opened and practiced from within a small faith-sharing group, over a 21-week process.
