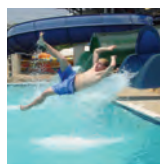
### JH Summer Events

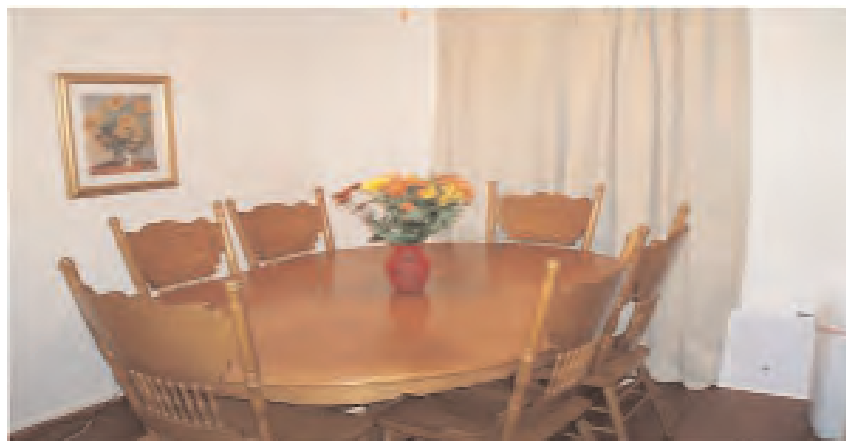
